- OER/ZTC Program Update, Sarah Harmon
- Open Educational Resources/Zero Textbook Cost
- End term goals Spring 2027
- Midterm goals 2024
- Making progress! More ZTC and Low cost (under \$40 cost) course adopters.
- The issue is not just the cost of textbooks, but also in needing to provide the infrastructure and support for fully online learning (internet connections, computers, access to (low cost) programs. It is a complex issue.
- RSI Definition
- We are needing to better define what Regular Substantive Interaction is at Cañada.
- Federal review is possible at any time in which the school and leadership can be held fully accountable for proof of RSI by professors teaching online, or risk losing accreditation.
- Other colleges have already faced similar inquiries and reviews.
- DE Modalities Definitions for Webschedule
- These have been approved through Fall 2022, to be revised and updated for Spring 2023 but there are issues:
 - Webschedule codes are not currently in sync with new descriptions.
 - Hyflex courses, as currently defined, are not fully inclusive and can not be listed, as I understand it. Veterans and Foreign students are the special cases.



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o In addition, we currently have no official designation for classes being taught in a multimodal, synchronous way even though this is the primary method in use on our campus.
