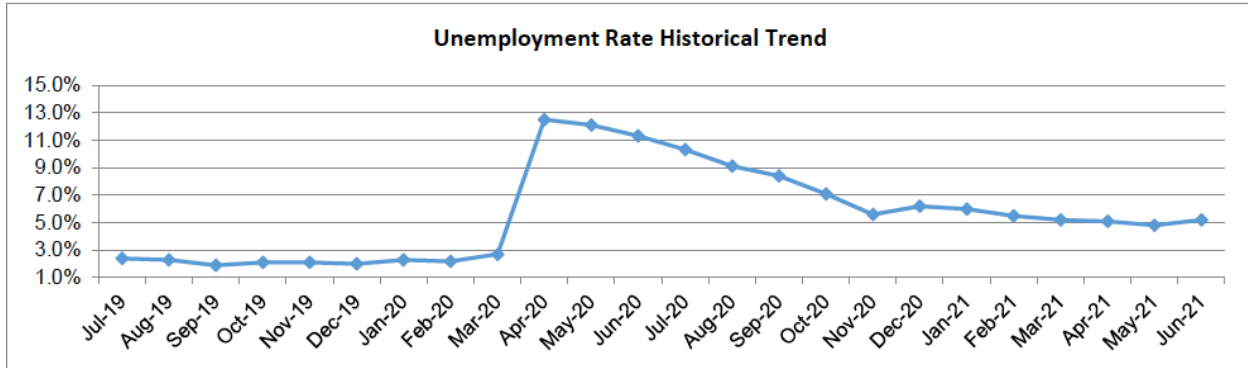

Notes: The unemployment rate in the San Francisco-Redwood City-South San Francisco MD was 5.2 percent in June 2021, up from a revised 4.8 percent in May 2021, and below the year-ago estimate of 11.3 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 8.0 percent for California and 6.1 percent for the nation during the same period.
