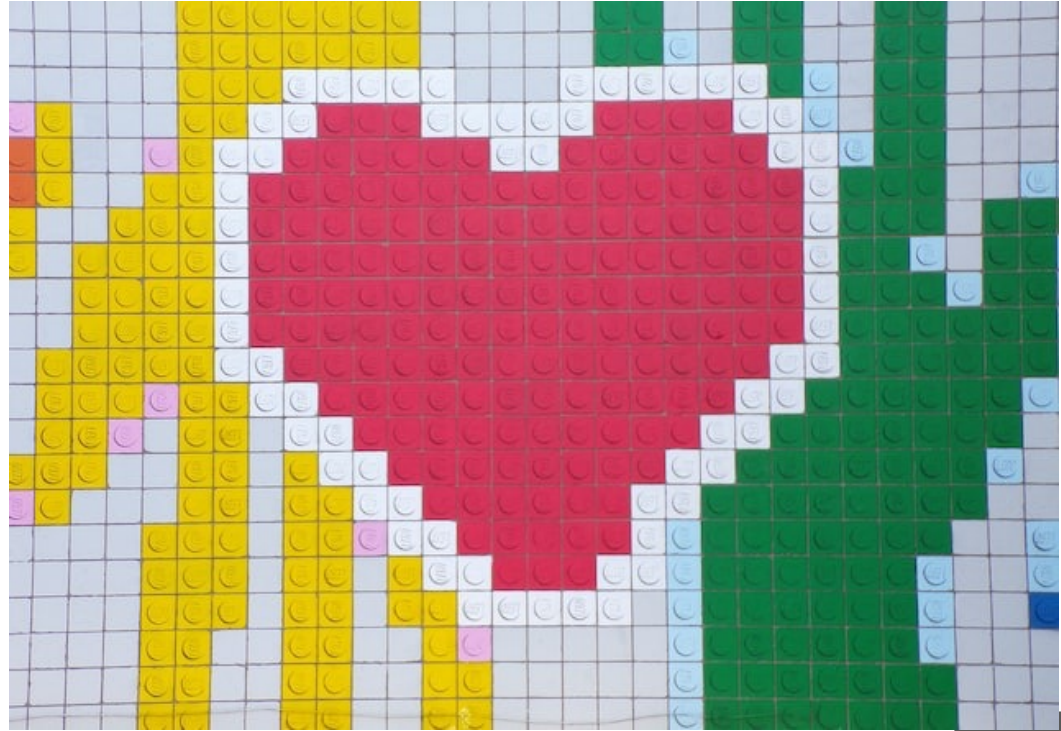

- Calculators
- Yoga mats

CCCCO ZERO-COST PATHWAYS GRANTS



PHASE 1

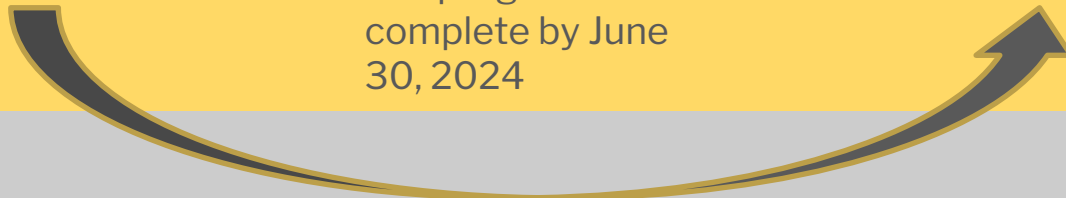
- \$20,000/college
- ‘By apportionment’ (= guaranteed)
- Meant to help plan for Phase 3
- Work to be done by June 30, 2023
- Cañada has received this funding now.

PHASE 2

- Up to \$200,000
- Competitive grants
- Meant to be for ADTs/CofAs that are mostly there, just need a bit more help
- If multiple colleges submit plans for similar projects, they can collaborate
- Funds must be spent and program complete by June 30, 2024

PHASE 3

- \$180,000
- ‘By apportionment’ (= guaranteed), **so long as** the college submits for Phase 1
- Creation of zero-cost ADTs and Certificates of Achievement
- Applications should open mid-2023





OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Colleges are to develop new or existing ADT/Certificate of Achievement zero-cost programs
 - Focus on high-value programs AND/OR meets an emerging regional business industry need AND/OR those with high textbook costs
- These funds can be used for professional development and technical assistance
- Pathways and hiring are determined locally
- Everything must be able to be institutionalized after the funding has run out
- Academic Senate is to be consulted with respect to implementation of the Pathways





OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Pathways must include:
 - Core courses
 - Selectives
 - GEs
- Need to offer as many sections as possible for each course as ZTC
- Materials adopted, remixed or authored must be accessible and customizable (CC-BY, CC-BY-NC)
- ADT/Certificate Pathways should be implemented within 3 academic years of receiving funding, if not sooner.





HOW DOES YOUR PROGRAM FIT IN?

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PHASE I: \$20,000 (IN OUR COFFERS NOW!)

- Spring 2023 cohort of ZTC Adopter Program (4-5 projects)
 - \$500 for training
 - \$750 for adoption; \$2,000 for remix
 - Focus on GE courses not already converted
- Funding for Library resources (e.g. eBooks, subscriptions)
- OER/ZTC Training for Student Tech Assistants, Embedded Tutors and Peer Mentors—On-going
- Fall 2022 ZTC/LTC Student Survey--Launched
 - What's working well?
 - What are the needs/challenges?





PHASE 3: \$180,000 (COMING IN 2023)

- Expanding to as many ZTC Pathways (both ADTs and Certificates) as possible
 - Likely candidates include ANTH, COMM, ECE, PHYS, MATH (they're the most ready right now)
 - Want to engage all departments in this work
 - Funds to expand ZTC Adoption Program to fall, spring and summer
- Addressing the student needs (data from student engagement work in Phase 1)
- Further funding for more Library resources (e.g. eBooks, subscriptions)
- Further training for faculty and students, including improving Canvas-based training
- ZTC Coaches (to allow for more projects to be funded throughout this process)
- Opportunity for faculty to author, not just remix/adopt

- Are any of the courses in our program currently offered as zero-textbook-cost (ZTC)? If so, which ones?
- Are any of the courses in our program currently offered as low-textbook-cost (LTC)? If so, which ones?
- Which of our courses are easier to convert to ZTC?
 - Are there materials out there already?
 - Are there other California CCs already offering these courses as ZTC?



WHERE ARE WE WITH GES?

IGET-C	ZTC OK?
<i>ENGLISH COMMUNICATION (6-9 units)</i>	Growing, especially in COMM, but could use more ENGL
<i>MATHEMATICAL CONCEPTS AND QUANTITATIVE REASONING (3 units)</i>	Can be done (3 ZTC), but could use more growth
<i>ARTS AND HUMANITIES (9 units)</i>	Good (9 ZTC), but need to work on more representation across disciplines
<i>SOCIAL AND BEHAVIORAL SCIENCES (9 units)</i>	Strong (14 ZTC, 6 LTC), but could use more representation across disciplines
<i>PHYSICAL AND BIOLOGICAL SCIENCES (7 units)</i>	Strong (12 ZTC), but could be stronger
<i>LOTE (1 course or equivalency)</i>	Only 3 course are ZTC; area of growth

CSU	ZTC OK?
<i>ENGLISH LANGUAGE COMMUNICATION AND CRITICAL THINKING (9 units)</i>	Improving, especially in COMM, but could use more ENGL, PHIL
<i>SCIENTIFIC INQUIRY AND QUANTITATIVE REASONING (9 units)</i>	Strong (15 ZTC), but could use more growth
<i>ARTS AND HUMANITIES (9 units)</i>	Good (14 ZTC, 4 LTC), but need to work on more representation across disciplines
<i>SOCIAL SCIENCES (6 units)</i>	Strong (17 ZTC, 4 LTC), but could use more representation across disciplines
<i>LIFELONG LEARNING AND SELF DEVELOPMENT (3 units)</i>	Adding more DANC/FITN courses, but not many courses available
<i>ETHNIC STUDIES (3 units)</i>	All ZTC!
