



OPEN TO ALL

Honors Courses

- Honors designated courses
 All courses are transferable
 - Open to all if course prerequisites are met

Honors Contract

- Can be applied to all transferable courses
- Online proposal due by week 9 of the semester, completion form due by finals week
- See canadacollege.edu/honorsprogram

MEMBERSHIP: Honors Transfer Program

- 3.3 GPA (or higher) in at least 9 transferable units or High School GPA of 3.5
- Eligibility for ENGL 100
- Eligibility for transfer-level MATH or current enrollment in a MATH class
- Online application required (see canadacollege.edu/honorsprogram)
- Program completion includes:
 - a minimum of 15 units of honors course credit with a "C" or better (a maximum of two courses can be from honors contracts)
 - have a minimum overall 3.3 transfer GPA
