

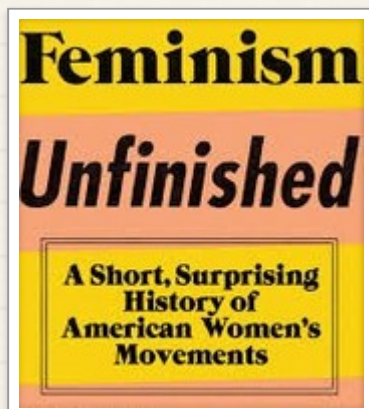
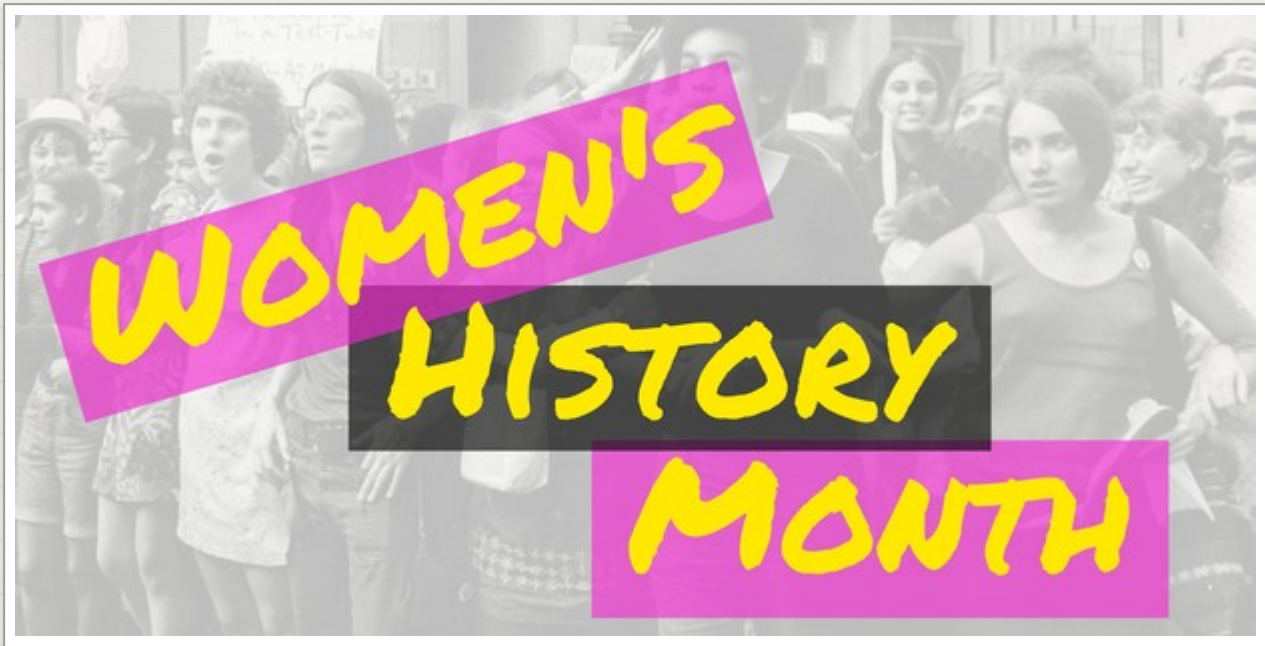
SPOTLIGHT ON INFORME

Informe es una colección de revistas Hispánicas con textos completos. Abarca negocios, salud, tecnología, cultura, temas de actualidad y otras materias.

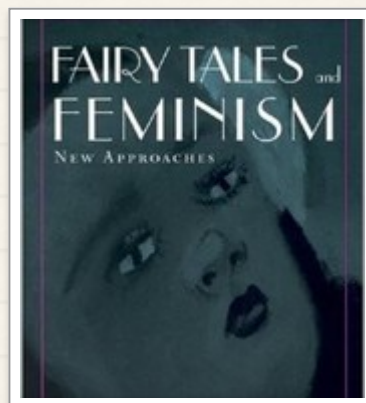
