Tips for Addressing Panopto Access Issues

More and more of you are beginning to use Panopto to record and host your course videos, which is great! I wanted to share some sample language that you can include in your courses to help students work through any access issues that they may encounter when trying to watch a Panopto video:

In this course, I use a tool called Panopto to store our course videos, like our Zoom recordings and/or class lecture videos. Here are a few tips for accessing Panopto videos if you run into any issues:

- If you see a button on a video asking you to sign in, click on it, and you should be signed in automatically through Canvas. But if you ever do need to sign in, your Panopto login is the same as your Canvas login information.
- If you ever encounter an 'Access Denied' type of message when playing a Panopto video, click on Panopto Video on the left in our course. After doing that, return to the video you were trying to watch and it should be available to you.
- If you're still having trouble with Panopto after trying these things, contact your instructor.

Giving Current Courses Access to Past Videos in Panopto

If you record a video in Panopto in one semester, and then import the course into your next semester shell, the access permissions should update to give your next semester students access to your past videos. But if you want to double check that, or give a current class access to a video outside of their course folder, here's a <u>Guide to Checking Panopto Sharing Settings</u>.
