Having Access Issues with Panopto?

If you've experienced students not being able to access your Panopto videos, there are two important things to try:

- 1. Is the video stored in your course folder? Students only have access to view videos that are stored in the folder of the course they're enrolled in. If you've stored a video in your 'My Folder', for example, your students in your courses may not be able to see that video if you haven't changed the sharing permissions.
- 2. Ask the student to click on Panopto Video on the left in your course. This can sync the student's Canvas and Panopto permissions and correct their access to your videos.

Reminders

Panopto Stats - See Who's Watching Your Videos

Did you know that you can view statistics on your Panopto videos to see who's watched your video, how much of your video is being watched and when your video is watched most. To view a videos' statistics, click on Panopto Video on the left in your course and click on Stats under your video. Just be sure to select 'Any time' from the drop down at the top right. Be default, this page only displays stats for the last 30 days, so you might initially see no views on a video you shared more than 30 days ago.
