Because the classrooms that COMM courses are scheduled in do not have computers or laptops in them, faculty are required to bring their own. Currently, all faculty in the department have their own laptops, but when students present their speeches, which is a requirement in the majority of the courses in the department, the faculty either have to allow the students to use their laptops to use the projector, or students have to bring their own or share one. Most faculty allow students to use their laptop, which does not allow faculty to grade their presentations electronically. By purchasing an iPad, faculty could allow the students to use their laptop for visual aid purposes, while also having the option to provide feedback electronically. Since faculty require students to submit a written version of their speeches electronically and provide a hard copy, having an iPad would not require students to pay to print the speeches. Additionally, the electronic feedback could be given right away through resources such as turnitin or the course management system (e.g., Webaccess). One iPad and pencil is being requested now with the hope of ordering more in the future.
