## Latinos Beyond Reel

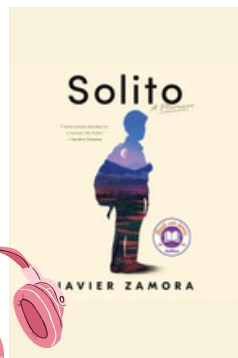
This series examines how US news and entertainment media portray -- and do not portray -- Latinos.



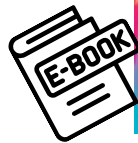
## Crash

2005 Best Picture set in present-day Los Angeles, where a dozen people experience different forms of racism that adversely affect their lives.

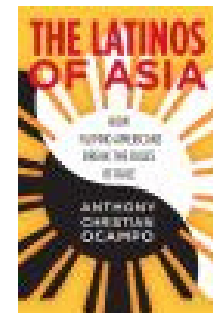

## PRINT AND ELECTRONIC RESERVE TEXTBOOKS

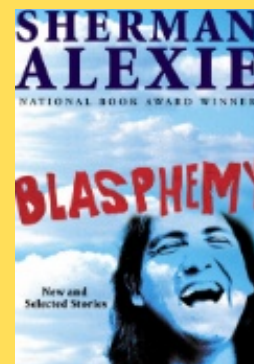
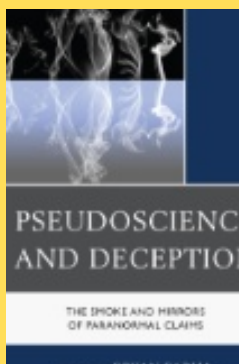
Course reserves are books that your instructor has made available to you to use in your course and held at the library.

**Physical** course reserves are available at the library's Circulation Desk, **electronic** textbooks are available via a link in OneSearch. Reserve materials are shared by all students for short-term or limited access use than regular items to ensure equal access to material for all students in a course. Only **currently** enrolled students can check-out reserve materials.
